- The Fitness Trail was bridged giving enthusiasts access to the rugged trail.

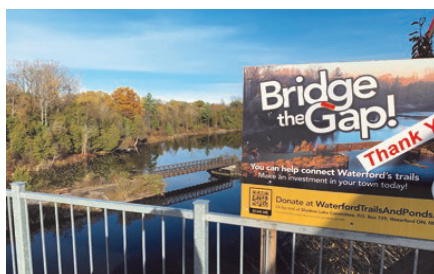
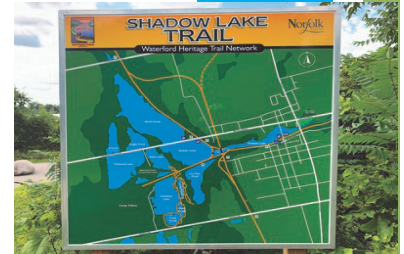
Funds for the bridge and the accompanying signage were funded by the Norfolk Community Foundation.
